Mandatory Volunteer Hours

Each family is asked to complete 12 volunteer hours per school year. If volunteer hours are not completed within the school year, your FACTS tuition account will be charged \$180.00 – all 12 hours must be completed to avoid the charge.

St. John Paul II Classical Catholic School (SJPIICCS) has many opportunities for family members to volunteer. In order to volunteer, you must do the following:

- Each volunteer is required by the Archdiocese of Detroit (AOD) and SJPIICCS to attend a Protecting God’s Children Workshop (PGCW).
- Each volunteer must submit to a Michigan State Police (MSP) (ICHAT) electronic background check.
- Each Volunteer must sign the Volunteer Code of Conduct.

You may sign up for the PGCW online at www.virtus.org/virtus or if you have already attended, please provide a copy of your certificate to the school office. You can view upcoming sessions by clicking on “First Time Registrant” and using Detroit Archdiocese as your organization. You may take the workshop at any location.

Complete the “Volunteer and Church Personnel Criminal Background Check Authorization Form” and the “Volunteer Code of Conduct”. Bring both forms along with your driver’s license to the school office.

Volunteering includes, but is not limited to field trips, lunch duty, library helper, classroom helper, coaching, concessions, event workers, etc.
